To provide funding for Federally qualified health centers and the National Health Service Corps.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Community Health5 Center and Primary Care Workforce Expansion Act of6 2019".

7 SEC. 2. COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER PROGRAM.

14	otherwise appropriated under section 10503(b) of the Pa-

16	254b-2(b)), there is authorized to be appropriated, and
17	there is appropriated, out of amounts not otherwise obli-
18	gated, for the community health centers program under
19	section 330 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
20	254b) for capital projects, \$4,600,000,000 for the period
21	of fiscal years 2020 through 2024.
22	(c) Availability of Funds.—Amounts appro-
