1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Those Who

5 Protected Us Act of 2013".

6 SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VETERANS 7 BENEFITS AND SERVICES.

8 There are hereby appropriated for fiscal year 2014,
9 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro10 priated, for any period during which interim or full-year

appropriations for fiscal year 2014 are not in effect, such
 sums as are necessary to administer and provide benefits
 and services to veterans, dependents, and survivors pro vided under chapters 11, 13, 15, 18, 21, 23, 30, 31, 33,
 35, and 39 of title 38, United States Code.

6 SEC. 3. TERMINATION.

7 Appropriations and funds made available and author8 ity granted pursuant to this Act shall be available until
9 whichever of the following first occurs:

10 (1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
11 (including a continuing appropriation) for any pur12 pose for which amounts are made available in sec13 tion 2.

14 (2) The enactment into law of the applicable
15 regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
16 other Act without any appropriation for such pur17 pose.

18 (3) January 1, 2015.
