What interested/inspired you to become an artist? What does being an artist mean to you?

Last year I did an independent study in realism, and creating pencil and charcoal portraits, and this was one of my pieces. I have a whole series similar to this one. This is a self portrait, copying a photo my mother took of me. I chose to draw this photo because not only was it a great memory, it also shows a bit of who I am.

Why do you think art is important? For our communities, for individuals, for society etc.

Art is incredibly important to our society, because, like writing, it's a great way to express ourselves. Humans have been making art since ancient times, not only to tell stories, but because some part of us craves beauty. We love symmetry and the geometry of nature, but we also just have the urge to create things.
