

## FOR THE 99.5% ACT

### Summary of Sen. Bernie Sanders' legislation to tax the fortunes of the top 0.5%

Over and over again, Republicans in Washington have professed their deep concern about the national debt and yet virtually all of them have signed onto legislation that would provide a \$1.8 trillion tax giveaway to billionaires by repealing the estate tax. This deficit hawk hypocrisy is off the charts.

At a time of massive wealth and income inequality, we need to make sure that people who inherit over \$3.5 million pay their fair share of taxes. We do not need to provide a huge handout to multi-millionaires and billionaires.

It is unacceptable that working families across the country today are struggling to file their taxes on time and put food on the table, while the wealthiest among us profit off of enormous tax loopholes and giant tax breaks.

The For the 99.5 Percent Act will begin to reform our rigged tax code that has benefitted the wealthy and powerful for far too long by reforming the estate tax.

This legislation would establish a progressive estate tax on the fortunes of the [top 0.5 percent](#). Instead of an America for the wealthy and the powerful, we need to create an economy that works for the 99.5 percent.

According to the Joint Committee on Taxation, a previous version of this bill would raise [\\$430 billion](#) over its first 10 years of enactment from the wealthiest 0.5 percent of families in America who inherit over \$3.5 million. No one who inherits less than \$3.5 million would pay a penny more in taxes under this bill. Importantly, it has been estimated that the families of just [735 billionaires](#) in America would pay up to \$1 trillion more in taxes if this legislation became law.

This legislation:

- **Exempts the first \$3.5 million of an individual's estate from the estate tax.**  
This plan would only impact the wealthiest 0.5 percent of Americans who inherit more than \$3.5 million (\$7 million for married couples). 99.5 percent of Americans would not see their taxes go up by one penny under this plan.
- **Establishes a new progressive estate tax rate structure as follows:**
  - 45 percent of the value of an estate between \$3.5 million and \$10 million;
  - 50 percent of the value of an estate between \$10 million and \$50 million;
  - 55 percent of the value of an estate between \$50 million and \$1 billion; and
  - 65 percent of the value of an estate in excess of \$1 billion.
- **Ends tax breaks for various trusts tax avoidance strategies.**  
Billionaires like the Walton family, who own the majority of Walmart's stock, have for decades manipulated the rules for trusts to pass fortunes from one generation to the next

without paying estate or gift taxes. This bill would:

- Strengthen the “generation-skipping tax (GST),” which is designed to prevent avoidance of estate and gift taxes, by limiting the exemption from the GST to taxable distributions to beneficiaries who either are within two generations of the transferor or alive at the creation of the trust.
  - Prevent abuses of grantor retained annuity trusts (GRATs) by barring donors from taking assets back from these trusts just a couple of years after establishing them to avoid gift taxes, while earnings on the assets are left to heirs tax-free. The lawyer who invented this technique for the Walton family claims it has cost the Treasury [\\$100 billion](#) since 2000.
  - Prevent wealthy families from avoiding gift taxes by paying income taxes on earnings generated by assets in “grantor trusts.”
- **Close arbitrage opportunities through the gift tax.**  
The bill would sharply limit the annual exclusion from the gift tax – which was meant to shield the normal giving done around holidays and birthdays from tax and recordkeeping requirements – for gifts made to trusts. In addition, the legislation eliminates gift tax rate arbitrage by applying it on a tax inclusive basis as the estate tax is applied.
  - **Closes other loopholes in the estate and gift taxes.**  
One of these loopholes involves “valuation discounts,” restrictions placed on interests in family businesses which are claimed, falsely, to reduce the value of the estate. Another loophole involves claiming that the value of an inherited asset is lower, for estate tax purposes, than what is claimed for income tax purposes to calculate gains when the asset is sold.
  - **Update the definition of executor.**  
The proposal would clarify and simplify executor responsibilities by updating the definition to expressly make it applicable for all tax purposes.
  - **Protects farm land and conservation easements.**  
The bill would protect family farmers by allowing them to lower the value of their farmland by up to \$3 million for estate tax purposes. The bill would also increase the maximum exclusion for conservation easements to \$2 million.

**Under this legislation, the families of all 735 billionaires in America who have a combined net worth of over \$4.5 trillion would owe up to \$2.8 trillion in estate taxes.** See chart on page 5 for more information.

More than a century ago, Republican President Theodore Roosevelt fought for the creation of a progressive estate tax to reduce the enormous concentration of wealth that existed during the Gilded Age.

As Teddy Roosevelt said, "The absence of effective state, and, especially, national restraint upon unfair money-getting has tended to create a small class of enormously wealthy and economically powerful men, whose chief object is to hold and increase their power. The prime need is to change the conditions which enable these men to accumulate power ... Therefore, I believe in a ... graduated inheritance tax on big fortunes, properly safeguarded against evasion and increasing rapidly in amount with the size of the estate."

While Roosevelt spoke those words on August 31, 1910, they are even more relevant today.

From a moral, economic, and political perspective, our nation will not thrive when so few have so much and so many have so little. We need a tax system which asks the billionaire class to pay its fair share of taxes and which reduces the obscene level of wealth inequality in America.

The fairest way to reduce wealth inequality, invest in the needs of working families with children, the elderly, the sick and the poor is to enact a progressive estate tax on the inherited wealth of multi-millionaires and billionaires.
